

## KARS TOUR

### A Day Tour to - Ani Ruins and Kars City



07:30 Departure to Kars. We will make a short visit to Çobandede Bridge on the way and continue our journey toward Ani Ruins. After a journey of about three hours, we arrive in Kars. Our first stop is the Ani Ruins, known as the “City of 1,001 Churches” and listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The Church of the Sac, the Church of the Icon, the Great Cathedral (Fethiye Mosque), After visiting important sites such as the Walls, the Lion’s Gate,

and the Emir Manuçehr Mosque, and viewing the Seljuk Palace from the outside, we conclude our tour of the Ani Ruins and after having lunch in Kars City Centre. Our first stop is the Fethiye Mosque, which was originally built as a stone church during the Russian occupation and later converted into a mosque following the recapture of Kars. We then head toward the Church of the Apostles (). After having the opportunity to see and photograph this thousand-year-old masterpiece—known for the 12 Apostles symbols on its facade and used as both a church and a mosque for centuries—we set off toward Kars Castle. Leaving this scenic spot where the entire city lies at your feet, we visit the Poets’ House—which offers a chance to experience Kars culture up close—and conclude our tour before heading to Erzurum. . We’re dropping you off at the same spots where we picked you up.
